Subject: Icom IC M802 microphone cords crumbling

If you were one of the lucky folks to get one of the defective microphone cords that came on some of the IC M802 units, Icom is standing behind the units and replacing the defective part.

I am not sure if they will want you to send your old microphone in or if they will send you a new microphone.

If they want you to send the microphone in, I recommend you buy one first so you can keep in operation. The HM-135 microphone can be found at several locations on the internet for less than \$70 and it is good to have a spare for some think you keep pulling on with a coiled cord.
